

Variation
 "Patch Quilt" is made by using three colors, one of which is the background color. Made as a closed wrap the same way as the above, except that the background color layout threads are placed **both** Up the rod and Down the rod, crossing each other.

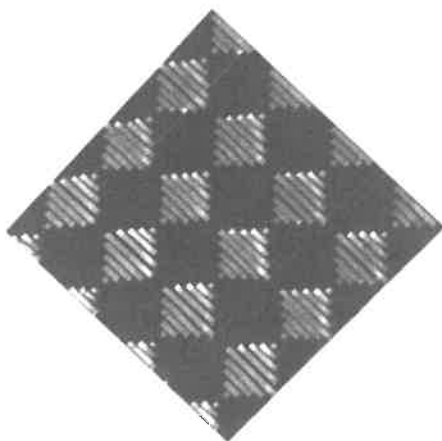
Notes
 Can be bordered all around to place "quilt" of small squares inside a large diamond. However, Gill feels it looks best when done as a closed wrap with entire blank covered with complete squares. In order for squares to close together evenly **ALL the layout threads** must be equidistant from each other. Careful numbering (labelling) of layout threads and "keeping track" is important.

"Continuous Quilt" in three colors.

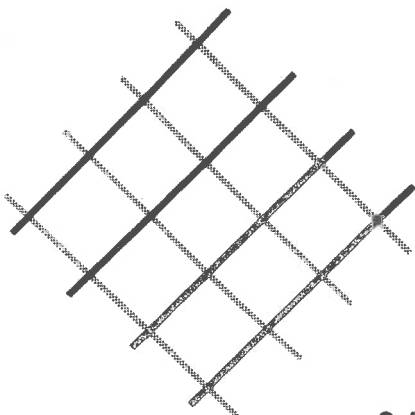


"Continuous Quilt", Gill Rowe.
